Mr Birch's undergraduate training was at the University of Newcastle upon Tyne Medical School (MBBS 1989). His postgraduate training was in surgery, obtaining FRCS (Eng) and the Royal College of Surgeons of England Penrose-May Prize (1993), and his Specialist Orthopaedic Training on the Mid-Trent Orthopaedic Training Programme based at the Queens Medical Centre, Nottingham, passing FRCS (Tr&Orth) 2003.



He completed a Specialist Fellowship in Knee Surgery under Mr Ian Forster in Nottingham, and Mr Tim Wilton in Derby and two Travelling Fellowships. The first was under Henrich Malchau and Mats Brittberg in Sweden, looking at the role of Autologous Cartilage Implantation (ACI).
